In two parts, the upper section with molded cornice, above a pair of arched panel doors opening to sliding shelves flanked by reeded stiles, the lower section with canted front corners centering two short and two long cockbeaded drawers, raised on ring turned tapering feet, the back bearing two Christie's lot labels. *Height 6 feet 10 inches (2.10 m), width 49 3/4 inches (1.26 m), depth 23 inches (58.4 cm).*
