CORRECTIONS

- Lot 27 Please note that the sitter for this portrait was Henry IV of France. He is shown wearing the Order of the Holy Spirit.
- Lot 36 Please note that the correct size of this panel is 18 x 28 inches (45.8 x 71 cm).
- Lot 40 Please note that the sitter for this portrait was Anne of Austria, Consort of Louis XIII and mother of Louis XIV of France. She is shown in mourning dress.
- Lot 51 Please note that the correct dimensions of this work are 17 3/4 x 11 inches (45 x 29 cm).
- Lot 55 Please note that this is a late 17th or early 18th century work, on canvas laid to panel. There is an indistinct inscription in the lower right corner.
- Lot 94 Please note that this work was purchased from the sale of the Felix Panhard Collection of miniatures, Paris, Palais Galliera, December 5, 1975
- Lot 226 Please note that the left frieze drawer has a penciled inscription to the underside: *Samuel Peat / fecit 1771*; the right frieze drawer has a penciled inscription to the underside: *Samuel Peat / the maker of this / Library Case 1771 / Brighton*. The maker is possibly Samuel Peat, whose birth was recorded in Chichester (23 miles from Brighton) in 1748, the father of nine children. It is possible that as a young man, he served in apprenticeship and worked as a journeyman in Brighton, where this bookcase cabinet was made. His father died in 1777, when he possibly returned to Chichester and established his business. He is recorded as a cabinet-maker, upholster and auctioneer from 1793-1823 at North Street, Chichester, Sussex. Four of his sons, William, Henry, James and Richard, succeeded him in the 1820s.
