CORRECTIONS

- Lot 3 Please note the correct estimate for this lot is \$4,000 – 6,000.
- Lot 22 Please note the Provenance was updated 6/23/21 - Provenance: The Wetmore Estate, Newport, RI. Parke-Bernet Galleries, 16-18 September 1969, lot 811. At the time of this listing, no other examples were extant.
- Lot 136 Please note the description was updated 6/23/21 - Pair of Continental Porcelain Gold-Ground Campana Vases and Covers. Circa 1820.
- Lot 144 Please note the condition report was updated 6/23/21 - Overall very nice condition, wear to the high-points, glaze flakes to the central cockerel decoration, typical rim chips and short hairline cracks (the longest approx. 3 in.), a minor chip to the pierced hanging hole.
- Lot 145 Please note the condition report was updated 6/23/21 – Rabbit example: damage and replaced section of rim from 8 – 11 o'clock, associated hairline crack to the center, glaze losses and overpainting to the rabbit, the repair now discolored and disrepaired.
- Monogrammed example: T-shaped hairline at 5 o'clock, additional hairlines 8 and 11, one issuing from an associated chip, typical wear and rim chips.
- Lot 146 Please note the condition report was updated 6/23/21 – Generally good condition, restoration to a small dime size area on the border at 11 o'clock, two sections of the rim restored at 3 and 5 o'clock (approx. 2 in.), the restoration now discolored and somewhat disrepaired, typical chips and hairline cracks, surface wear mainly to the underside
